

Substance Use and Abuse Among Children and Adolescents

This three-hour instructor-led online course is offered in two 1.5-hour sessions via a virtual classroom platform (Go to Training), enabling individuals to participate from their desks.

This distance learning training will review the substances commonly abused by children and adolescents, define addiction paths and criteria, and introduce treatment options and techniques for youth with addiction.
